GENERAL PROVISIONS:

The shows is held under the FCI and A.Ch.R. Show regulations. Only dogs registered with stud books recognized by FCI can enter the show. Imported dogs of Romanian owners must be registered with the Romanian Stud book. Applications lacking any necessary document (a copy of the International working certificate for the working class, a copy of the Championship certificate for the champion class) will be automatically entered into an open class without any notification. A copy of a pedigree and a copy of a proof of the payment must be enclosed to each application. Should the owner forget to indicate the class or should he/she do it incorrectly (regarding the age), the organizer will enter the dog into a relevant class. Documents received after the second entry close will not be accepted. Fill in a separate form for each dog. Applications could be sent by post, fax, and e-mail or on-line. For the entries send by fax, you must call on the same day to verify the reception and the correctness of your applications. Please, enter your dog only once, do not double or triple your entries. The receipt of an application will be confirmed in 48 hours after the sending. Organizer cannot take the responsibility for the undelivered applications even if they were sent by registered mail.

The exhibitor commits to pay the exhibition fees even when he/she will not take part at the show. Should the show will not be held for the unforeseen causes the exhibition fees will be used to cover the expenses. The organizer may not accept the application without stating the reason. The organizer cannot be held responsible for damages caused by/to a dog. Owner is responsible for any damages caused by the dog. Owners of the dogs awarded by BOB title are obliged to take part at the final competitions; otherwise they cannot claim a BOB prize. A judge is obliged to disqualify aggressive dogs. Provoking dogs against each other is not allowed. It is forbidden to treat the coat, skin or nose with anything that alters the structure, color or form. Double handling from outside the ring is forbidden. It is strictly forbidden to leave dogs tied up on trimming tables except the time they are prepared for the show (trimmed, brushed or combed). Selling puppies at the exhibition grounds is strictly forbidden. It is not allowed to enter the dog on the day of the show. It is not allowed to change class on the day of the show.

VETERINARY REGULATIONS: Dogs from abroad must have a PET PASSPORT with valid vaccinations.

Conditions for obtaining the title of R.Ch. (Excerpt from A.Ch.R. Show Regulations):

- 1. The title **ROMANIAN CHAMPION** may be awarded for the breeds without working trial to the dog that has obtained at least 3 C.A.C. titles from three different judges. For the homologation of the title there will be taken into consideration:
- · 1 x C.A.C. obtained in C.A.C.I.B.or Club show
- · 1 x C.A.C. obtained in national C.A.C. show
- · 1 x C.A.C. obtained in Championship show
- 2. The title **ROMANIAN** CHAMPION for the breeds with working trial may be awarded to the dog that has obtained at least 2 C.A.C. titles from at least 2 different judges. To the request there will be annexed the copy of the international working certificate. For the homologation of the title there will be taken into consideration:
- · 1 x C.A.C. obtained in C.A.C.I.B. show
- · 1 x C.A.C. obtained in Championship show
- · 1 x maximum qualification* obtained in club show
- * for the breeds for which there are no kennel clubs, this qualification may be replaced with a title of C.A.C. obtained in national C.A.C. show.

For the obtaining of the Romanian Champion title, for the breeds for which the working trial is necessary for the homologation of the C.A.C.I.B. title, the requesters shall also attach a copy of the international working trial certificate (F.C.I. model).

- 3. The title "ROMANIAN CHAMPION" may also be awarded to the dog that is already champion of another F.C.I. member country and obtains the C.A.C.I.B. title in a show in Romania. Also, the title of "ROMANIAN CHAMPION" shall be awarded to the dog that obtains the C.A.C.I.B. title in the OPEN show annually organized within an international C.A.C.I.B. show
- 4. The title "ROMANIAN CHAMPION" shall also be awarded to the dogs that are already champions in F.C.I. member countries with which the Romanian Kennel has signed special agreements. These agreements are an integral part of the present rules.

Conditions for obtaining the title of R.ChC.L. (Excerpt from A.Ch.R. Show Regulations):

5. The tile "Romanian Champion CUM LAUDAE" (R.Ch.L.), is awarded to the dog that is already champion of Romania and has obtained two **C.A.C.L.** *titles* in Champion class.

Conditions for obtaining the title of R.J.Ch. (Excerpt from A.Ch.R. Show Regulations):

- 6. The title "Romanian Junior Champion" (R.J.Ch.) is awarded to the dog that has obtained *two C.A.C.J. titles* from at least two different judges, one of the titles being obtained in a *CACIB show*. Also, the title of "ROMANIAN JUNIOR CHAMPION" may be awarded to the dog that obtains the Best Junior title in the OPEN show annually organized within a C.A.C.I.B. show. All titles need to be obtained in Romania.
- 7. The title "ROMANIAN VETERAN CHAMPION" (R.Ch.V.), is awarded to the dog that has obtained two C.A.C.V.titles in Veteran class.
