Dr. Rickard's near life-long interest in purebred dogs and her extensive medical knowledge has motivated her to

become an AKC conformation judge. To her credit, Dr. Rickard's accomplishments, her impartiality and known eye for quality has already led her to have been contacted by Airedale clubs from around the world to judge at their breed specialties.

Dr. Rickard has been published in two veterinary textbooks and often donates her time by conducting seminars and presentations on canine reproduction, pediatrics, and related topics. She is frequently published in magazines such as Terrier Type and other newsletters.
